3000 MILES OF HOSPITALITY

This is one of a series of nine menu cards featuring some of the more prominent Fred Harvey hotels, restaurants and sight-seeing tours in scenic and historic areas and in metropolitan centers. A complete set of this series is available upon request.

Along the right bank of the Little Colorado River, just north of the much-traveled US Highway 66, lies one of the most impressive of Arizona's scenic wonders—the multihued badlands of the Painted Desert which are part of the world-famous Petrified Forest National Monument. Much as the front page photograph seems to show of this dazzling "sea of colors," it actually depicts but a small fraction of this bizarre land, which extends many miles north and westward. The Painted Desert can best be seen from a scenic drive off US Highway 66, circling the edge of the desert. On its northern-most point, where the rim juts peninsula-like into the frozen

sea of tinted waves, stands the Painted Desert Inn, a rambling structure in pueblo style, whose landscaped terraces afford the most magnificent view of the badlands. Built by the National Park Service, the Inn has been operated by Fred Harvey since 1947. There are no overnight accommodations, but soda fountain service and simple meals are available. In addition, there are interesting exhibits of Indian and Mexican curios. The Painted Desert Inn is one of the smallest, yet, in its enchanting seclusion, one of the most charming Harvey Houses.
