3000 MILES OF HOSPITALITY

This is one of a series of nine menu cards featuring some of the more prominent Fred Harvey hotels, restaurants and sight-seeing tours in scenic and historic areas and in metropolitan centers. A complete set of this series is available upon request.

In 1954 Fred Harvey branched out into another Midwestern State by taking over several operations in the Wisconsin Dells, world-famous scenic resort area 195 miles northwest of Chicago. This new undertaking followed the transfer of ownership of a major portion of the Dells property to the Wisconsin Alumni Research Foundation for the benefit of the University of Wisconsin. The property operated by Fred Harvey for the foundation includes a number of facilities for tourists and sightseers. One is the Hotel Grandall, a pleasant resort hotel in the city of Wisconsin Dells, surrounded by spacious grounds overlooking the picturesque Wisconsin

River. Another is the Dells Boat Company, which maintains a fleet of modern steel motor boats for conducted sightseeing trips through the Upper and Lower Dells—one of the major attractions of the region. (The picture on the front page shows the Clipper "Winnabago" passing Romance Cliff in the Upper Dells.) Of much lure and interest to tourists is also the Fred Harvey Trading Post at the Dells Park Indian Village, where Indians live in replicas of their native homes and Pueblo silvermiths from the Southwest and Winnabago basket weavers and beadmakers can be seen at work.
